- What should you do during the exam?
 - Bring sharp pencils, good erasers
 - Spend a proportionate amount of time on each section
 - Answer questions in this order:
 - First easy, then hard
 - First high point value, then low point value
 - Answer ALL questions – partial credit is your friend
 - Write legibly

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- What should you do during the exam?
 - Read EVERY word (watch for “NOT” and “EXCEPT,” codon or anticodon, etc.)
 - Read EVERY choice!
 - Answer EVERY part!
 - Don't assume you know what it is asking
 - Ask me to explain questions that are not clear.
 - If there's time, cover your answers and rework problems.
 - Look for careless mistakes.

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- What should you do during the exam?
 - Second-guessing is usually BAD.
 - In general: Change your first answer only IF you're *sure* it was wrong (e.g. you misread the question)
 - Double-check your scantron
 - Did you forget to bubble any in?
 - Did you accidentally “double-bubble”?
