THE QUIZZES WILL CONSIST OF APPROXIMATELY EIGHT PROBLEMS <u>VERY SIMILAR</u> TO HOMEWORK PROBLEMS. CREDIT WILL BE GIVEN FOR THESE PROBLEMS ONLY IF YOU SHOW YOUR WORK. I RESERVE THE RIGHT TO HAVE **OTHER QUIZZES** AT ANY TIME, IN ANY FORMAT, AND FOR ANY AMOUNT OF POINTS. IF THERE ARE ANY OTHER QUIZZES, THE TOTAL POINTS POSSIBLE WILL BE ADJUSTED ACCORDINGLY.

THE FINAL EXAM WILL ALSO BE WORTH 100 POINTS AND WILL CONSIST OF ITEMS SIMILAR TO THOSE THAT HAVE APPEARED ON THE PREVIOUS EXAMS AND QUIZZES. ANY TOPIC DISCUSSED AT ANY POINT IN THE SEMESTER IS A POSSIBILITY FOR THE FINAL EXAM. IF YOU DO NOT TAKE THE FINAL EXAM, YOUR GRADE FOR THE COURSE WILL BE 'F'

MINIMUM EXAM SCORES:

IF ANY OF YOUR EXAM SCORES IS BELOW 50%, YOU CANNOT RECEIVE A GRADE OF "A" FOR THE COURSE, NO MATTER WHAT YOUR PERCENTAGE WORKS OUT TO BE. THIS APPLIES EVEN IF AN EXAM SCORE IS REPLACED (SEE NEXT SECTION).

MAKE-UP EXAMS:
