THESE WILL BE WORTH 2 POINTS EACH, ALL OR NOTHING – NO PARTIAL CREDIT! **TYPE II**: APPROXIMATELY 12 PROBLEMS <u>VERY SIMILAR</u> TO HOMEWORK PROBLEMS. CREDIT WILL BE GIVEN FOR THESE PROBLEMS ONLY IF YOU SHOW YOUR WORK. THE FINAL EXAM WILL CONSIST OF APPROXIMATELY 20 MULTIPLE CHOICE QUESTIONS TAKEN, IN SLIGHTLY MODIFIED FORM, FROM THE PREVIOUS EXAMS, AND APPROXIMATELY 20 TYPE II PROBLEMS TAKEN, IN SLIGHTLY MODIFIED FORM, FROM THE PREVIOUS EXAMS. ANY TOPIC DISCUSSED AT ANY POINT IN THE SEMESTER IS A POSSIBLE ITEM FOR THE FINAL EXAM. **IF YOU DO NOT TAKE THE FINAL EXAM YOUR GRADE FOR THE COURSE WILL BE 'F'**.

CHAPTER QUIZZES #1 – 4 WILL CONSIST OF APPROXIMATELY 8 – 12 PROBLEMS <u>VERY SIMILAR</u> TO HOMEWORK PROBLEMS. CREDIT WILL BE GIVEN FOR THESE PROBLEMS ONLY IF YOU SHOW YOUR WORK. I RESERVE THE RIGHT TO HAVE **OTHER QUIZZES** AT ANY TIME, IN ANY FORMAT, AND FOR ANY AMOUNT OF POINTS. IF THERE ARE ANY OTHER QUIZZES, THE TOTAL POINTS POSSIBLE WILL BE ADJUSTED ACCORDINGLY.

BASIC FORMS QUIZZES #1 – 5 WILL CONSIST OF APPROXIMATLY 20 OF THE VARIOUS BASIC FACTS DEVELOPED DURING THE COURSE. THEY WILL BE WORTH 20 POINTS EACH AND YOUR SCORE WILL BE EITHER 20, 15, 5, OR 0 DEPENDING ON WHETHER YOU MISS ZERO, ONE, TWO, OR MORE THAN TWO, RESPECTIVELY.

MINIMUM EXAM SCORES:

IF ANY OF YOUR EXAM SCORES IS BELOW 50%, YOU CANNOT RECEIVE A GRADE OF "A" FOR THE COURSE, NO MATTER WHAT YOUR PERCENTAGE WORKS OUT TO BE. THIS APPLIES EVEN IF AN EXAM SCORE IS REPLACED (SEE NEXT SECTION).

- A. THE FINAL EXAM MAY NOT BE REPLACED.
- B. IF YOU MISS TWO EXAMS, ONLY ONE WILL BE REPLACED.
