

## Solving Linear Equations 3

Solve the following equations. SHOW YOUR WORK!

$$1) \quad -3x + 2 = -4$$

$$2) \quad -6x + 5 = -4x + 3$$

$$3) \quad 2x + 1 = 2(x - 3) + 4$$

$$4) \quad 6x + 5 = 4(x + 1) + 1$$

$$5) \quad \frac{1}{2}x + \frac{1}{3} = \frac{5}{6}x - \frac{3}{4}$$

$$6) \quad \frac{1}{2}(x + 5) = \frac{1}{3}x + \frac{1}{4}$$

$$7) \quad \frac{x}{8} + \frac{x}{12} - \frac{x}{6} = 1$$

$$8) \quad 0.04x + 0.08(20 - x) = 1.4$$

$$9) \quad 5x + 4 = 3(2x - 1) - x + 7$$

$$10) \quad 5(2x + 4) - (x - 6) = 10$$
