- All papers must be typed in Times New Roman 12 or Courier 10 if a paper is deemed to have been typed in a larger font, a <u>minimum of 15 points</u> will be deducted.
- <u>CONCERT REVIEWS DUE BY FRIDAY, APRIL 27 at 11:59</u>. No late submissions will be accepted.
- The summary should address group/artist, where performance took place, did you like/dislike it, what did you like and dislike about it, what was performed, what was the venue like, have you heard the artist/performer before, how did the performances differ, would you see it again, what were your expectations, etc.
- The summary should not address where you ate for dinner that night, if you
 got lost going there, how much the parking cost, how many drinks were
 consumed, etc.
