RELIGIOUS PLURALISM AND TRUTH

What does one do with the many / pluralism of religions and the question of religious truth?

What do you mean by 'religion'?

At minimum, one would mean some specific core / tradition / creed taken to be the 'essence' of a religious tradition.

What do you mean by 'truth'?

- 1. Empirical-Factual / Scientific truth
- 2. Historical truth
- 3. Metaphysical (nature of ultimate reality)truth
- 4. Personal-Spiritual truth
- 5. Poetic Aesthetic truth
 - Opposed to 1 and 2 and 3

Options / Views:

- 1. "No- religion- is- true" view (atheism, naturalism-materialism)
- 2. "Only- my- religion- is- true" view = Exclusivism
 - 1) In every claim / detail
 - 2) In core claims(s)
- 3. "My- religion- has- the- final/complete-truth" view = Inclusivism
 - 1) Necessary to accept the 'more and finally true' religion
 - 2) Not necessary to accept the 'more and finally true' religion
- **4.** "All-religions-are-true" view = **Pluralism**
 - 1) No religion can be judged to be "better than" another
 - 2) Some "better than" judgments can be made between religions
