## 'Selfishness' and 'Self-Interest'

'Other-Benefit' (objective sense)

Interest <u>IS</u> the other: Interested in welfare / benefit of other

(and other only?)

'Self-Interest' (subjective sense)

= interest(s)  $\overline{OF}$  the self You are interested in / concerned for benefits to self - but not self only (can include benefit to others = Interest <u>IS</u> one's self: Interested in welfare / benefits of self (and self only?)

(**objective** sense = 'Self-Benefit')

'Self-Interest'

as one's moral interest)

Benefit to other as as GOAL

of action (benefit to other is the motive intention)

= Possibly unselfish

Benefit to other as as BY-PR0DUCT

of action benefit to other is not the motive -

intention) = Not unselfish Benefit to self as BY-PRODUCT

of action (benefit to self is not the motive intention)

= *Not* selfish!

Benefit to self as GOAL

of action (benefit to self is the motive intention)

= Possibly selfish

Other-Benefit DOES

1) suspend self- rights 2) disregard

self-needs

= 'UNSELFISH'

Other-Benefit DOES NOT

1) suspend self-rights 2) disregard self-needs

='NON-SELFISH' (is not 'unselfish'!) Self-Benefit DOES NOT

2) disregard basic needs of others

= 'NON-SELFISH' (is not /selfish'!)

Self-Benefit DOES

1) violate rights of others 1) violate rights of others 2) disregard the basic needs of others

= 'SELFISH'
