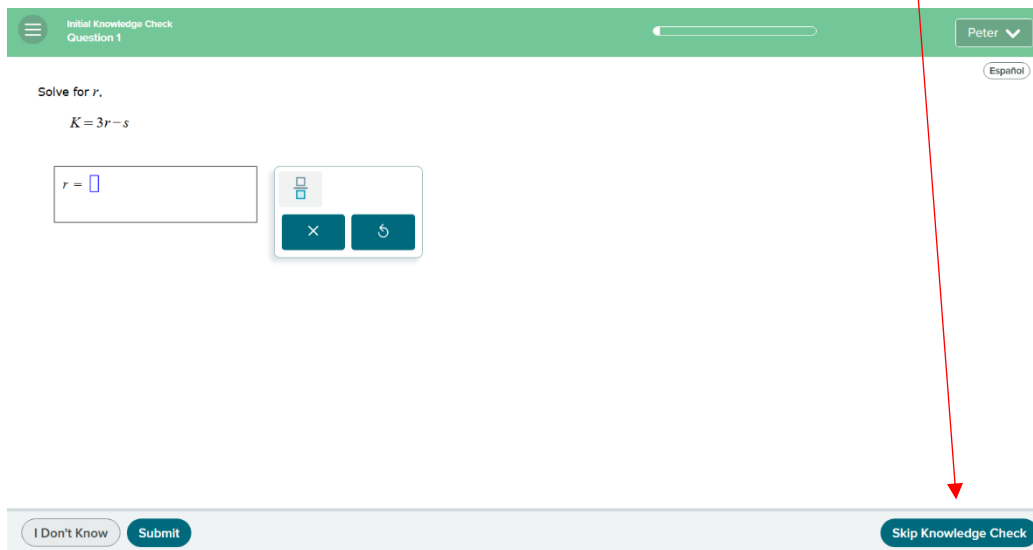


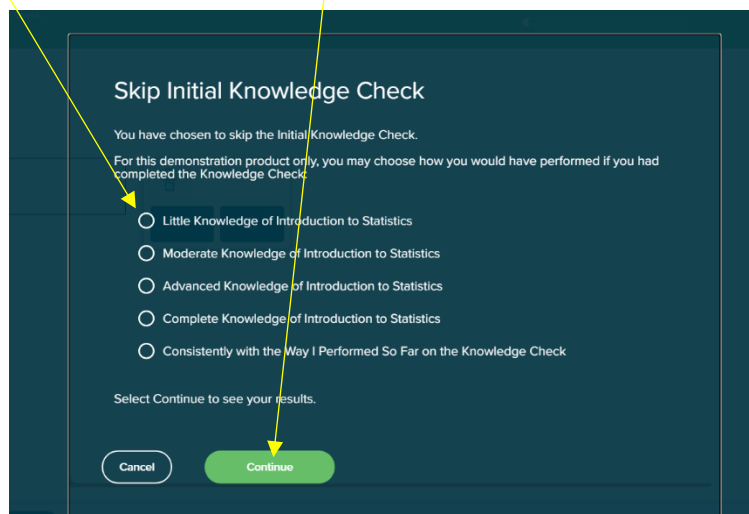
To begin working on the Homeworks, follow these instructions:

Start the Initial Knowledge Check, and then click on the Skip Knowledge Check button.



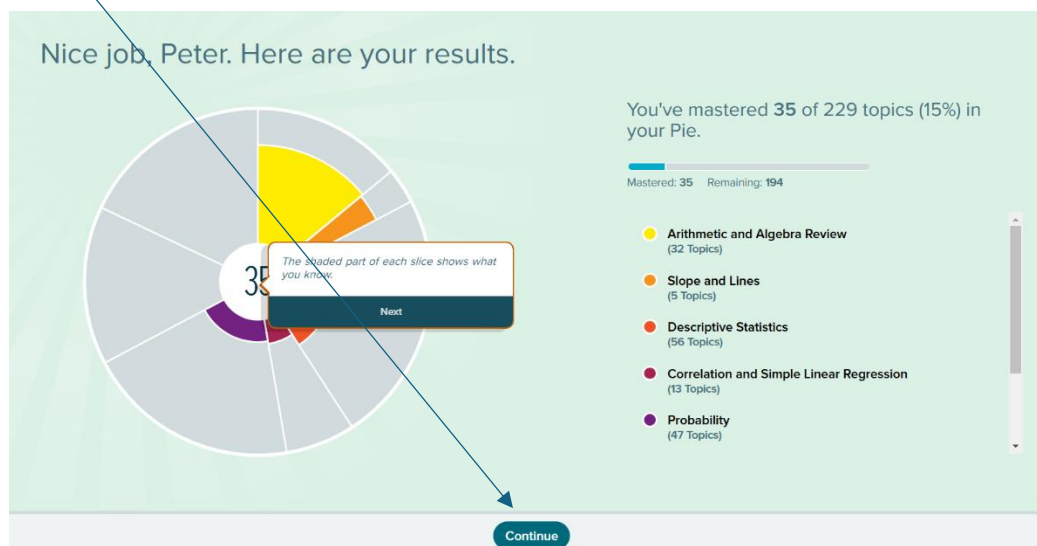

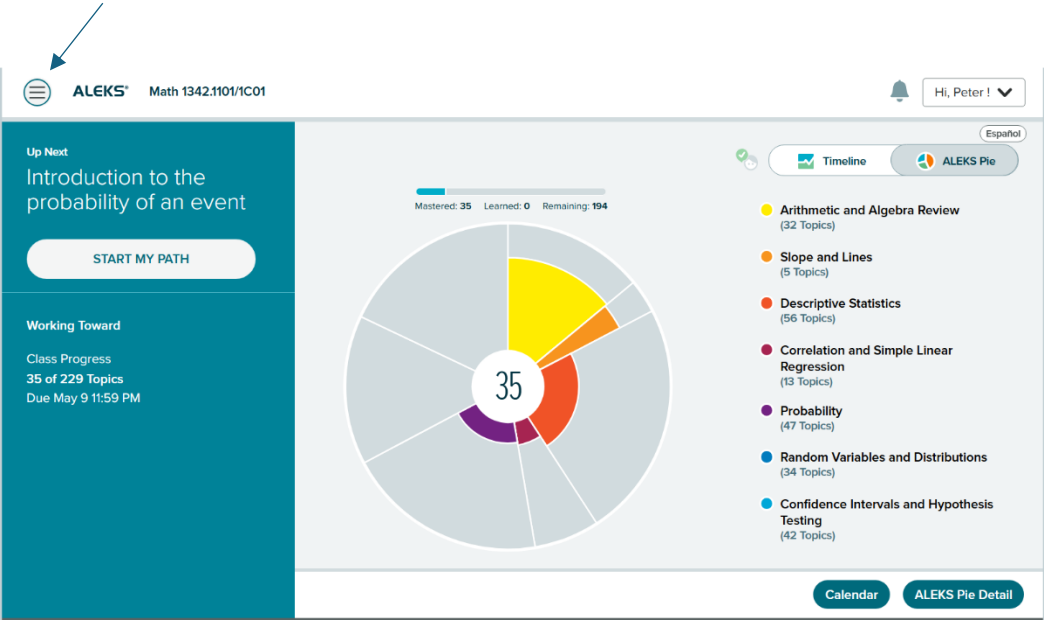
