

From LSC-CyFair Biology department:

Thank you for your interest in the Human A&P I course (BIOL 2401) at LSC-CyFair. BIOL 2401 is the first part of a two-semester A&P course and is a requirement for many Allied Health Programs. The course is challenging and you will be required to take the **pre-A&P assessment** to test your readiness for BIOL 2401. The pre-A&P assessment is available free of cost and is a password-protected online assessment that can be taken from any **LSC assessment center** during their regular hours of operation (see link at end). The hour-long test consists of 55-60 questions and covers basic Biology, Chemistry and Mathematics. You will be able to see your scores immediately after you submit the assessment. If you **score less than 51%** on the assessment, it is highly recommended that you take **BIOL 2404 – Introductory A&P** course before taking BIOL 2401 in order to prepare you well for the challenges of BIOL 2401.
