

Extra Credit Guide for Exam 3

You can obtain up to a **maximum of 10 extra credit points** for Exam 3 by completing the Practice Exam 3 (the one labeled Practice Exam for Extra Credit on my website).

The maximum score for the Practice Exam is 100. Here is how the extra credit points will be rewarded based on the score you obtain. (I will grade your work on the practice exam just like I will grade your work on the real exam)

96 - 100	10

Please print out every page of the exam, including the first page with the instructions and score table and complete the exam by writing directly on the pages. You do not need to show work on the multiple choice part but you must show all work on the written part. **Please print out the assignment report page and fill it out.** Use the assignment report as a cover sheet and **staple it together with the Practice Exam.**

ANY SUBMISSION THAT DOES NOT FOLLOW THE ABOVE INSTRUCTION WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED OR GRADED FOR EXTRA CREDIT.

The practice exam is due in class on Monday, November 14th. I will post the solution on D2L the day after so that you can use the solution to study for the actual exam on Wednesday.

Any extra credit points you earn from this can be used for Exam 3 and Exam 3 only.

Your score on exam 3 will be computed using the formula:

$\text{Exam 3 score} = \min \{ \text{earned score} + \text{extra credit score}, 100 \}$

For example, if you earn 95 points for the exam and earn 7 points extra credit. Your score will be $\min\{95+7, 100\} = \min\{102, 100\} = 100$. In other words, you cannot get more than 100 points on the exam and the extra points over 100 will be forfeited.
