

## HONORS CALCULUS I - MINI-PROJECTS POLICY

- Each project is due at the beginning of class on the date listed in the class calendar. Late work will be accepted, but every late week will cost you 25% of earned credit. No late project will be accepted after the last day of class.
- You can collaborate with your classmates, however, you must list the names of all your collaborators. More importantly, everything that you submit must be in your own words and from your understanding. Simply copying other student's work constitutes cheating and will result in a score of zero and possibly further penalties.
- You can use any books or any source on the internet, however, you must list all your references.
- Feel free to use any computational tools, including graphing calculators, Maple or Mathematica for your computations. However, specify what tool(s) you use.
- Each question in a project is worth 3 points. Zero point for no attempt, 1 point for a somewhat serious attempt, 2 points for a substantial attempt in the right direction, 3 points for neatly written, complete, and correct answer with every step in the solution fully justified.
- Please type your answers to the questions in each project using MS Word (with MathType) or LaTeX (a free, highquality typesetting system for scientific document). I am happy to help you set up and use LaTeX.
- Handwritten projects are accepted but you can only earn at most 75% of earned credit.
